On behalf of Miller-Keystone Blood Center (MKBC), I would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to our organization and *The Life Blood of Our Community*.

MKBC is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and is the sole community blood center to 28 hospitals in 15 eastern Pennsylvania counties and 5 western New Jersey counties. I invite you to join MKBC in achieving our mission of *saving lives by partnering with our community to provide a continuous supply of blood products and services*.

Every day, MKBC provides blood products to treat: trauma, bleeding and immune system disorders, cancer, burns, accident victims, heart surgery, organ transplants, and bone marrow transplants. Due to COVID-19, MKBC has been experiencing challenges maintaining a safe and stable blood supply. Striving to preserve our mission, we have partnered with the Greater Wilkes Barre Chamber of Commerce to establish *The Life Blood of Our Community* - a collaboration with five local nonprofit organizations to recruit new blood donors and raise needed operating funds.

Included in the group are the American Cancer Society, North Branch Land Trust, CASA of Luzerne County, Osterhout Free Library, and Wyoming Valley Children's Association. *The Life Blood of Our Community* will be hosting a three-day event on December 3rd-5th, 2020 at MKBC's blood donor center, located at 400 Route 315 Suite E, Pittston Township. Our goal is to collect 150 units of blood during this three-day event and raise sponsorship funds for the participating nonprofit organizations.

Just imagine, one unit of blood helps to save three lives, this means that when our goal is achieved, we will be able to help 450 patients, including premature infants, those with cancer, leukemia, and traumas.

About The Life Blood of Our Community Organizations:

Miller-Keystone Blood Center (MKBC): MKBC is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and licensed by the Food and Drug Administration in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Maryland. Since 1971, MKBC has provided a vital community service that saved thousands of lives, our work is twofold:

1. Recruiting and collecting blood from volunteer donors
2. Processing and delivering blood products to the hospitals we serve.

For almost 50 years, hospitals have trusted MKBC to deliver blood products when needed. In 2018, over 116,000 blood products (red blood cells, platelets, and plasma) were delivered to 28 hospitals in our service region, including Geisinger Wyoming Valley and Geisinger Medical Center. In addition, the mission of MKBC is to save lives by partnering with our community to provide a continuous supply of blood products and services.

American Cancer Society: At the American Cancer Society, we're on a mission to free the world from cancer. Until we do, we'll be funding and conducting research, sharing expert information, supporting patients, and spreading the word about prevention. All so you can live longer — and better. We help patients access lifesaving care and resources with programs such as Hope Lodge and Road to Recovery, but COVID-19 is putting that support at risk. Your support helps ensure cancer patients, survivors and caregivers continue to get the support they need and the continuation of critical Cancer Research which is very much at risk right now.

North Branch Land Trust: North Branch Land Trust conserves the natural, working, and scenic landscapes in Northeastern Pennsylvania that enrich our lives. CASA focuses 100% on an unmet need in our community. Right now there are more than 500 Luzerne County children in the foster care system. They have experienced abuse, neglect, fear, trauma, and shame. We know that when a child has one caring, compassionate, and committed adult in their lives, they flourish. Our volunteer advocates step into the "messiness" of a child's life, to ensure they receive the services they need, to advocate for placement in a safe, nurturing, and permanent home, and to provide them with hope that their past doesn't have to define their future.

Osterhout Free Library: Where would many of us be without the information we find in our public libraries? When you show support for the Osterhout Free Library, you are not just supporting the library, you are giving back to the community. Many Luzerne County residents utilize the library's programs to continue their education after their school-age years, to conduct research and study for post-secondary school exams, and to immerse their children and grandchildren into the wonders of reading. The Osterhout Free Library is a dynamic, versatile community center. In 2019, we welcomed over 125,000 visitors. More than half of young adults and seniors living in poverty in Luzerne County came to the Osterhout to access the Internet and participate in life enriching programs. They used this access among other purposes to find work, apply to college, secure benefits, learn new skills, and file for unemployment. To many, the Osterhout is a lifeline.

Wyoming Valley Children's Association: Wyoming Valley Children's Association (WVCA) is a very special school located in Forty Fort, PA. Founded in 1924, WVCA is proud to be serving the Wyoming Valley for over 96 years. WVCA is a top provider of early childhood education and therapy services for children with a wide array of developmental and physical disabilities, such as autism, Down Syndrome, cerebral palsy and more, as well as typically developing children. Our educational programs include *The Together We Grow* Preschool, Kindergarten and infant/toddler daycare. WVCA offers physical, occupational, speech and music therapies to students in need. WVCA also provides home-based therapy and education services and we host the CATCH (Childhood Autism Team Check) Clinic that helps to diagnose autism and related conditions. We truly believe in every child's unique potential and strive to minimize and/or eliminate the effects of developmental delays through therapeutic services and quality education. By serving ALL children, WVCA creates an inclusive environment for children to discover and develop into curious learners and compassionate citizens.
