- Over time, this group has volunteered more than 73,000 hours for MKBC
- One member served for nearly 36 years as a volunteer
- There are 28 members who have served 10 or more years

The fact is, our volunteer staffers are a vital part of our team helping us achieve our mission of saving lives by partnering with our community to provide a continuous supply of blood products and services every day. Our volunteers work in canteens, at blood drives, and in our offices handling administrative duties. We operate strongly and efficiently because of the generosity of time from our volunteers. Each individual has a different reason for their service to MKBC – one volunteer says it was a lifelong dream to give back because their dad's life had been saved by blood transfusions and she just wanted to meet some blood donors; others want something social to do; still others just want to give back to their community and volunteering with MKBC seemed like a good place to do it.

Red blood cells must be used within **42 days** of donation, while platelets only have a usable lifespan of **7 days**. This is why having a steady stream of blood donors is critical to the health and welfare of our community!

We can request a text blast to be sent out to past blood donors (if you have previously sponsored a mobile drive), as well as to blood donors in your surrounding zip code(s). Sometimes it can help get those last few empty spots filled! Ask your account manager for more info!
