

What blood type is referred to as the "Universal Donor?"

Individuals with the O-negative blood type are referred to as "Universal Blood Donors." This is because the red blood cells of a universal blood donor may be transfused to anyone, regardless of their blood type.


This is especially important in accident/trauma cases, where there may not be time to determine a patient's blood type.
