THE IMPORTANCE OF PLATELETS

Platelets are one of the main components of blood, and help to control bleeding and bruising, by helping to form clots and allow wounds to heal.



Since they help control bleeding, platelets are very important for heart surgery patients, burn victims,

organ transplant patients, bone marrow transplant patients, accident victims, premature babies, and especially cancer patients, who are the largest patient group requiring platelet transfusions.

Eligible donors can safely give platelets as often as every eight days (up to 24 times per year). What's important to understand is that platelets have the shortest shelf life of all blood components, **lasting only 7 days.** Therefore, there is a constant need for platelets - and platelet donors - to help ensure that they are available for lifesaving treatments at our regional hospitals.
