During this time, colleges and universities in the Lehigh Valley are competing with each other to see who can collect the most blood donations. These donations can be made at college-sponsored MKBC blood drives, as well as at MKBC donor center locations (including

Allentown, Bethlehem and Easton).

Participating schools have a goal of 4% of their student population. If the goal is attained, the school will receive a \$1,000 award for its college scholarship fund, with the winning college or university being awarded a \$10,000 award for its scholarship fund. In addition, student and school faculty donors will have the opportunity to win randomly selected prizes, such as gift cards, air pods or sneakers.

Lehigh University currently leads this year's competition, with Penn State Lehigh Valley and Moravian University looking to take over the lead!
