#7: "My Blood Isn't Rich Enough."

The minimum hemoglobin level to donate blood is 13.0 (men) and 12.5 (women). Don't hesitate ask our collections staff for tips on boosting your iron, including <u>making some iron-rich foods part</u> <u>of your regular diet</u>.


